

2020 Annual Customer Summary – Lowell Light & Power

Energy Waste Reduction (EWR) Report Summary - MPSC Case Number U-18302

Lowell Light & Power contracted with Franklin Energy through the Michigan Public Power Agency (MPPA) – Energy Efficiency Service Committee (EESC) to administer the EWR efforts in order to comply with 2008 PA-295, as amended by 2016 PA-342. Lowell Light & Power also self-implemented some EWR Programs in 2018. The Michigan Municipal Electric Association (MMEA) filed a biennial 2-year EWR Plan with the Michigan Public Service Commission (MPSC) on August 1, 2017, as required by 2008 PA-295, as amended by 2016 PA-342.

In 2020, Lowell Light & Power spent \$95,323 on EWR Programs and achieved 795 MWh of energy savings.

MMEA filed a joint 2020 EWR Annual Report for Lowell Light & Power with the MPSC on May 28, 2021.

Renewable Energy Report Summary – MPSC Case Number U-16620

Lowell Light & Power has taken the following actions to comply with the REP standards:

Filed a 20-year Renewable Energy Plan (REP) with the MPSC on March 31, 2009 as required by PA 295. The REP was found to be in compliance on July 1, 2009.

Lowell Light & Power filed a Biennial Review of REP on November 30, 2017 and was found to be in compliance by MPSC on April 12, 2018.

Lowell Light & Power acquired from renewable energy systems during the reporting period 13,975 MWh of renewable energy. Lowell Light & Power acquired 13,999 Renewable Energy Credits (RECs) and 173 Incentive-Renewable Energy Credits (iRECs) for the 2020 reporting period.
